

LD Outround Quick Reference Guide

We realize that the new procedures for determining resolution and sides, in outrounds, is a lot to remember, so we are providing you with this handy quick reference guide.

LD Debaters should carry to each round:

1. All materials for both of your cases.
2. This reference sheet
3. A quarter

Both Resolutions will be debated.

Outrounds

- A judge asks who wants to call sides and has them state heads or tails.
- A judge flips the coin and declares which side is up.
- The student winning the coin toss has the option to choose either to debate Affirmative or Negative, or to choose which resolution to debate.
- If the student winning the coin toss chooses Aff or Neg, the other student chooses the resolution.
- If the student winning the coin toss chooses the resolution, the other student chooses Aff or Neg.
- The coin toss winner makes his/her choice first, then the other student makes his/her choice second.
- **If sides are already locked (because the debaters met in prelims), the student winning the coin toss will choose the resolution.**
