moral standards.

Resolution 2:

Resolved: In the United States federal jurisprudence, the

letter of the law ought to have priority over the

spirit of the law.

Round <u>1</u>, <u>3</u> and <u>4</u> will be debating <u>Resolution 2</u>.

Round 2, 5 and 6 will be debating Resolution 1.

Prelim Round protocol

All Round 1 pairings will debate resolution 2 and Round 2 pairings will debate resolution 1.

Round 3 and 4 pairings will debate the resolution 2 with each student debating Affirmative and Negative.

Round 5 and 6 pairings will debate the resolution 1 with each student debating Affirmative and Negative.
